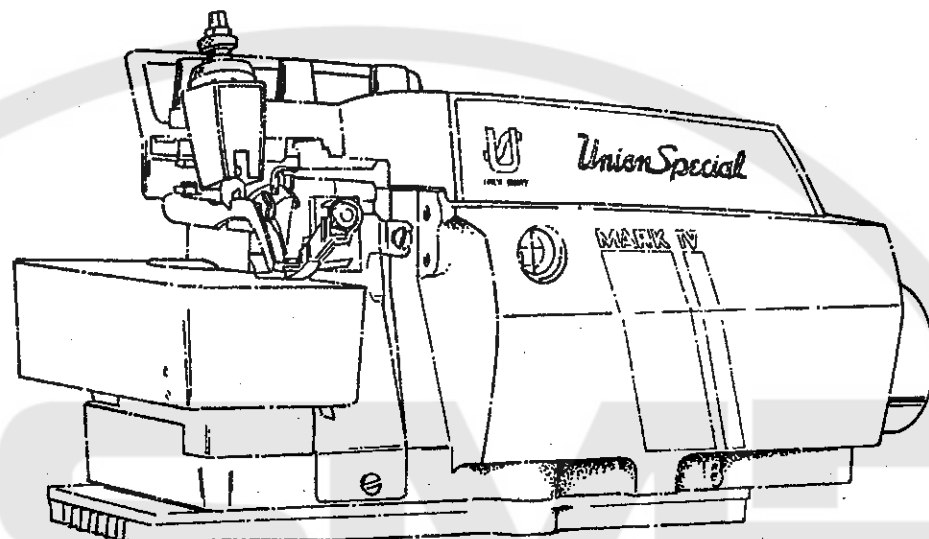

PREFACE

This parts manual has been prepared to assist you in locating individual parts or assemblies on 39500 Series machines. It can be used in conjunction with Union Special Adjusting Manual INS9207.

It is the desire of Union Special that each machine run at its optimum performance. Parts listed in this manual are designed specifically for your machine and are manufactured with utmost precision to assure long lasting service.

This manual has been comprised on the basis of available information. Changes in design and/or improvements may incorporate a slight modification of configuration in illustrations or part numbers.

On the following pages are illustrations and terminology used in describing the parts used on 39500 Series machines.

SAFETY RULES



General Operating Directions

The sewing machines described in this instruction manual are prohibited from being put into service until it has been ascertained that the sewing units, in which these sewing machines will be built-in have conformed with the EC Council Directives (89/392/EEC, Annex II B).

1. Before putting the machines described in this manual into service, carefully read the instructions. The starting of each machine is only permitted after taking notice of the instructions and by qualified operators.

IMPORTANT! Before putting the machine into service, also read the safety rules and instruction from the motor supplier.

2. Observe the national safety rules valid for your country.
3. Each machine is only allowed to be used as foreseen. The foreseen use of the particular machine is described in paragraph "STYLES OF MACHINES" of this instruction manual. Another use, going beyond the description, is not as foreseen.
4. All safety devices must be in position when the machine is ready for work or in operation. Operation of the machine without the appertaining safety devices is prohibited.
5. The following safety devices are components of the sewing machines: Finger guard, needle lever eyelet guard, needle bar guard, needle break protection shield and handwheel-belt guard.
6. When gauge parts are exchanged (e.g. needle, presser foot, needle plate, feed dog and bobbin) during threading, when the operator leaves the workplace, and during service work, the machine must be isolated from the main power by switching off the main switch or disconnecting the main plug. On mechanically operated clutch motors without a start inhibitor it is necessary to wait until the motor has stopped.

7. Wear safety glasses.
8. In case of machine conversions and changes all valid safety rules must be considered. Conversions and changes are made at your own risk.
9. Commissioning of the sewing head is prohibited until such time as the entire sewing unit is found to comply with EC regulations.
10. The warning hints in the instructions are marked with one of these two symbols:



Items require special attention



Danger of injury to operative or service staff

Be sure to observe and adhere to these indications and to the generally applicable regulations.

Special Operating Directions

11. For the following the machine has to be disconnected from the power supply by turning off the main switch or by pulling out the main plug:
 - 11.1 For threading needle(s), looper, spreader etc.
 - 11.2 For replacing sewing parts such as needle, presser foot, throat plate, looper, spreader, feed dog, needle guard, folder, fabric guide etc.
 - 11.3 When leaving the workplace and when the workplace is unattended.
 - 11.4 For maintenance work.
 - 11.5 When using clutch motors without actuation lock, wait until the motor is stopped totally.

General Maintenance Directions

12. Maintenance, repair and conversion work (see item 8) must be done only by trained technicians or special skilled personnel under consideration of the instructions.
13. Any work on the electrical equipment must be done by an electrician or under direction and supervision of special skilled personnel.

Special Maintenance Directions

14. Work on parts and equipment under electrical tension is not permitted. Permissible exceptions are described in the applicable sections of standard sheet DIN VDE 0105.
15. Before doing maintenance and repair work on the pneumatic equipment, the machine has to be disconnected from the compressed air supply. In case of existing residual air pressure after disconnecting from compressed air supply (e.g. pneumatic equipment with air tank), the pressure has to be removed by bleeding.

Exceptions are only allowed for adjusting work and function checks done by special skilled personnel.

17. The sewing machines described in this manual are built according to the following standards:

IEC204-3-1/EN60204-3-1 Electrical equipment of industrial machines. Part 3: Particular requirements for sewing machines, units and systems.

ORDERING REPAIR PARTS

ILLUSTRATIONS

This manual has been arranged to simplify ordering repair parts. Exploded views of various sections of the mechanism are shown so that the parts may be seen in their actual position in the machine. On the page opposite the illustration will be found a listing of the parts with their part numbers, description and the number of pieces required in the particular view being shown.

Numbers in the first column are reference numbers only, and merely indicate the position of the part in the illustration. The reference number should never be used in ordering parts. Always use the part number listed in the second column.

Component parts of sub-assemblies which can be furnished for repairs are indicated by indenting their descriptions under the description of the main sub-assembly. As an example refer to the text below.

It will be noted in the above example that the cam follower, bushing and cam guide and the upper looper drive shaft are not listed. The reason is that replacement of these parts individually is not recommended, so the complete upper looper drive shaft assembly should be ordered.

When a part is common to all machines covered in this manual, no specific usage will be mentioned in the description. However, when the parts for the various machines are not the same, the specific usage will be mentioned in the description and, if necessary, the difference will be shown in the illustration.

A numerical index of all the parts shown in this manual is located at the back. This will facilitate locating the illustration and description when only a part number is known.

IDENTIFYING PARTS

Where the construction permits, each part is stamped with its part number. On some of the smaller parts and on those where construction does not permit, an identification letter is stamped in to distinguish the part from similar ones.

PLEASE NOTE: Part numbers represent the same part, regardless of which manual they appear. On all orders please include part number, name and style of machine for which the part was ordered.

NEEDLES

Each needle has both a type and size number. The type number denotes the kind of shank, point, length, groove, finish and other details. The size number, stamped on the needle shank, denotes the largest diameter of the blade measured between the shank and the eye. Collectively, the type number and size number represent the complete symbol which is given on the label of all needles packed and sold by Union Special.

When changing the needle, make sure it is fully inserted in the needle driving arm before the nut is tightened.

To have needles promptly and accurately filled, an empty package, a needle sample, or the type and size number should be forwarded. Use the description on the label. A complete order should read as follows: "100 needles, type 154 GAS, size 070/027".

TERMS

Prices are net cash and subject to change without notice. All shipments are forwarded F.O.B. shipping point. A charge is made to cover postage and insurance.

TORQUE REQUIREMENTS

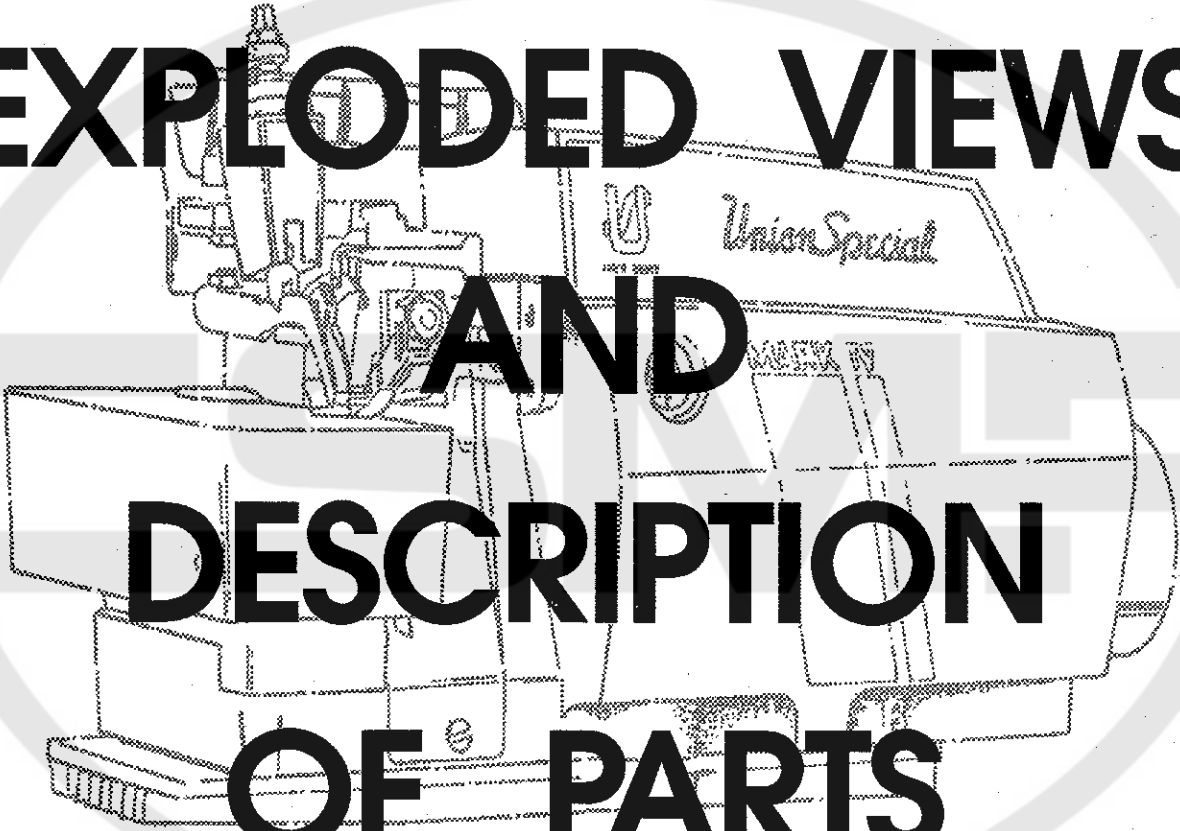
Torque measured in inch-pounds or centimeter/kilograms is a rotating force in pounds applied through a distance by a lever in inches, feet or meters. This is accomplished by a wrench, screwdriver, etc. Many of these devices are available, which when set at the proper amount of torque will tighten the part to the correct amount and no tighter.

All straps and eccentrics should be tightened to 26-28 inch-pounds (2.9-3.2Nm) unless otherwise noted. All other nuts, bolts, screws, etc. should be tightened by hand as tightly as possible, unless otherwise noted.

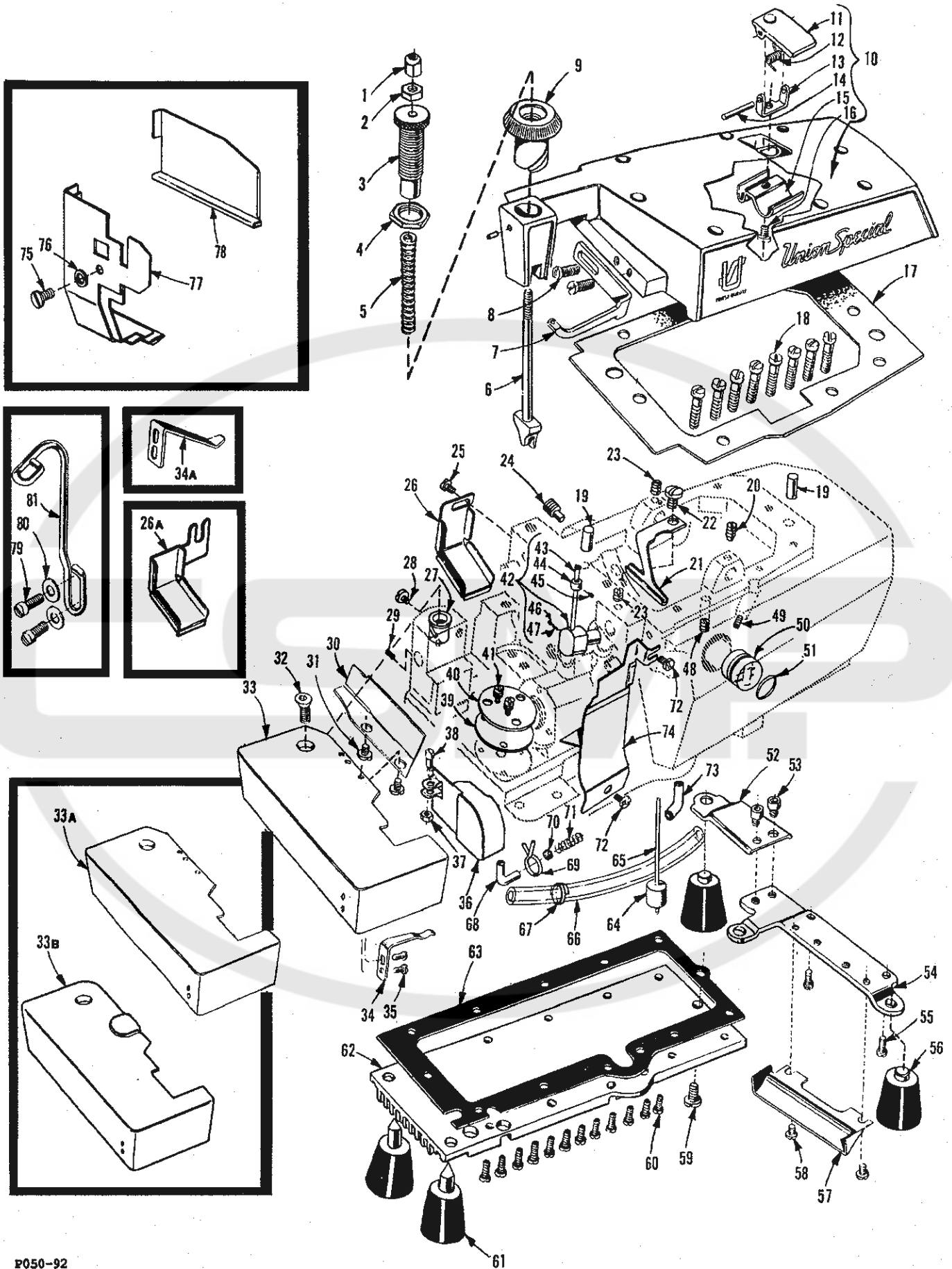
Screws requiring a specific torque will be indicated on the illustrations in 39500 Parts Manual PRT9206.

* Metering pins have been selected according to oil flow requirements. Each machine has been fitted with a pin that will provide approximately 10 to 15 milligrams of oil per minute for speeds from 7500 to 8000 RPM.

Recommended clearance between the metering pin and the crankshaft is .0005" to .001" for speeds above 7500 RPM. For speeds below 7500 RPM a .001" to .002" clearance is recommended.

Oil flow is determined by the sewing speed and machine usage. It may become desirable to either increase or decrease the amount of oil flow by changing the size of the metering pin. In most cases selecting a pin one size larger or one size smaller will provide the correct oil flow. Refer to Chart 'A'.



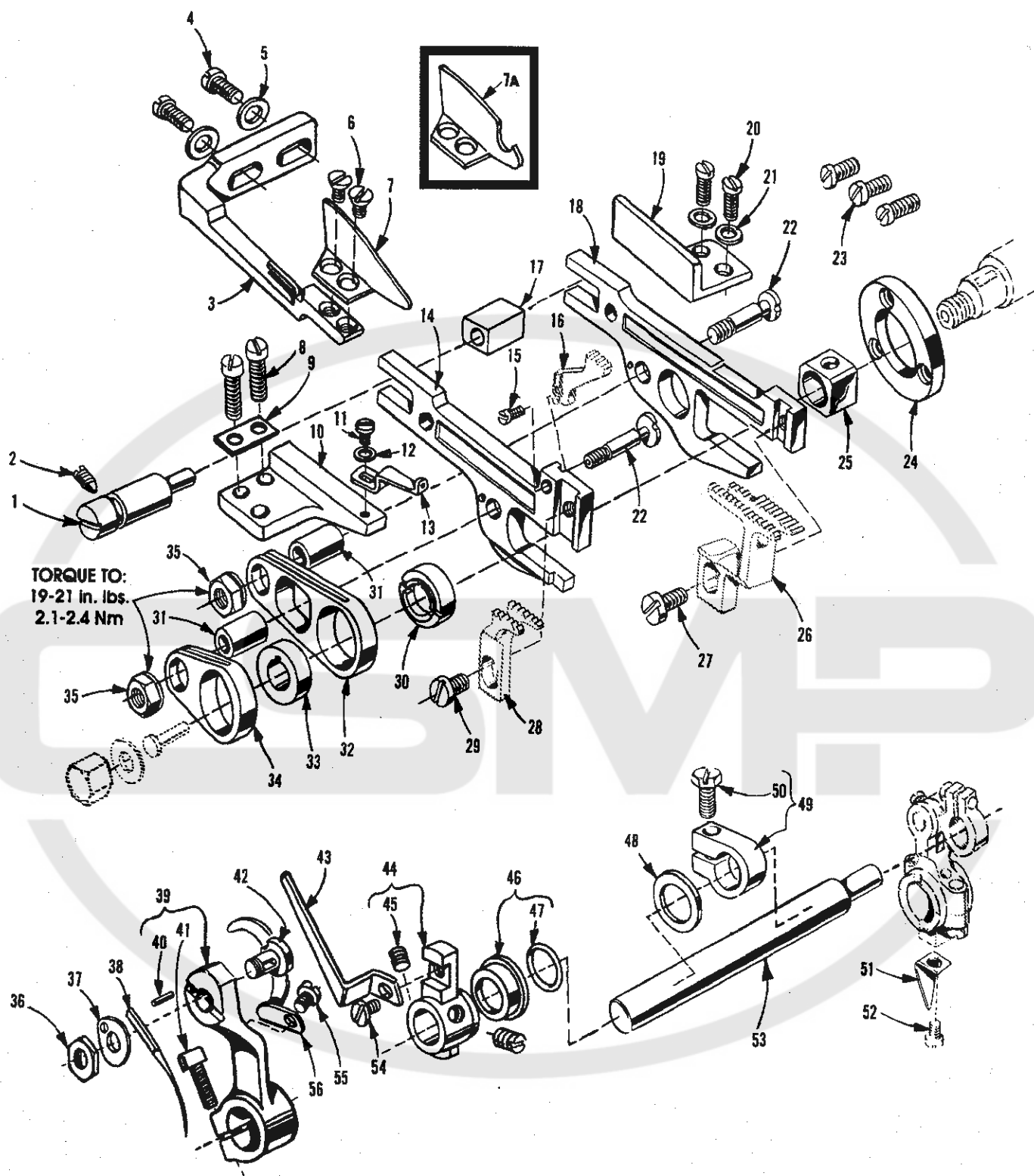

UPPER & LOWER LOOPER DRIVING PARTS

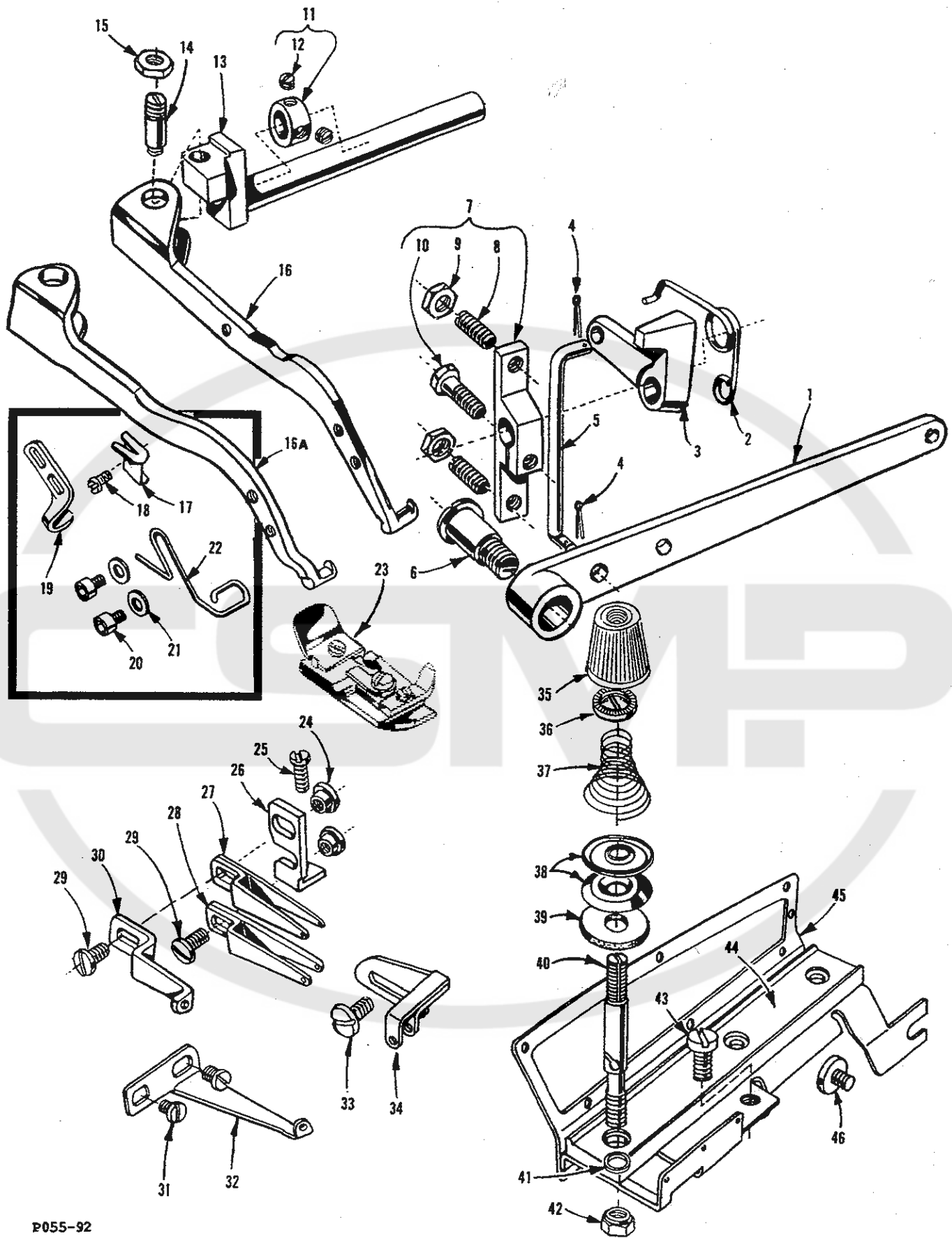

FEED DOGS, THROAT PLATE & PRESSER FEET

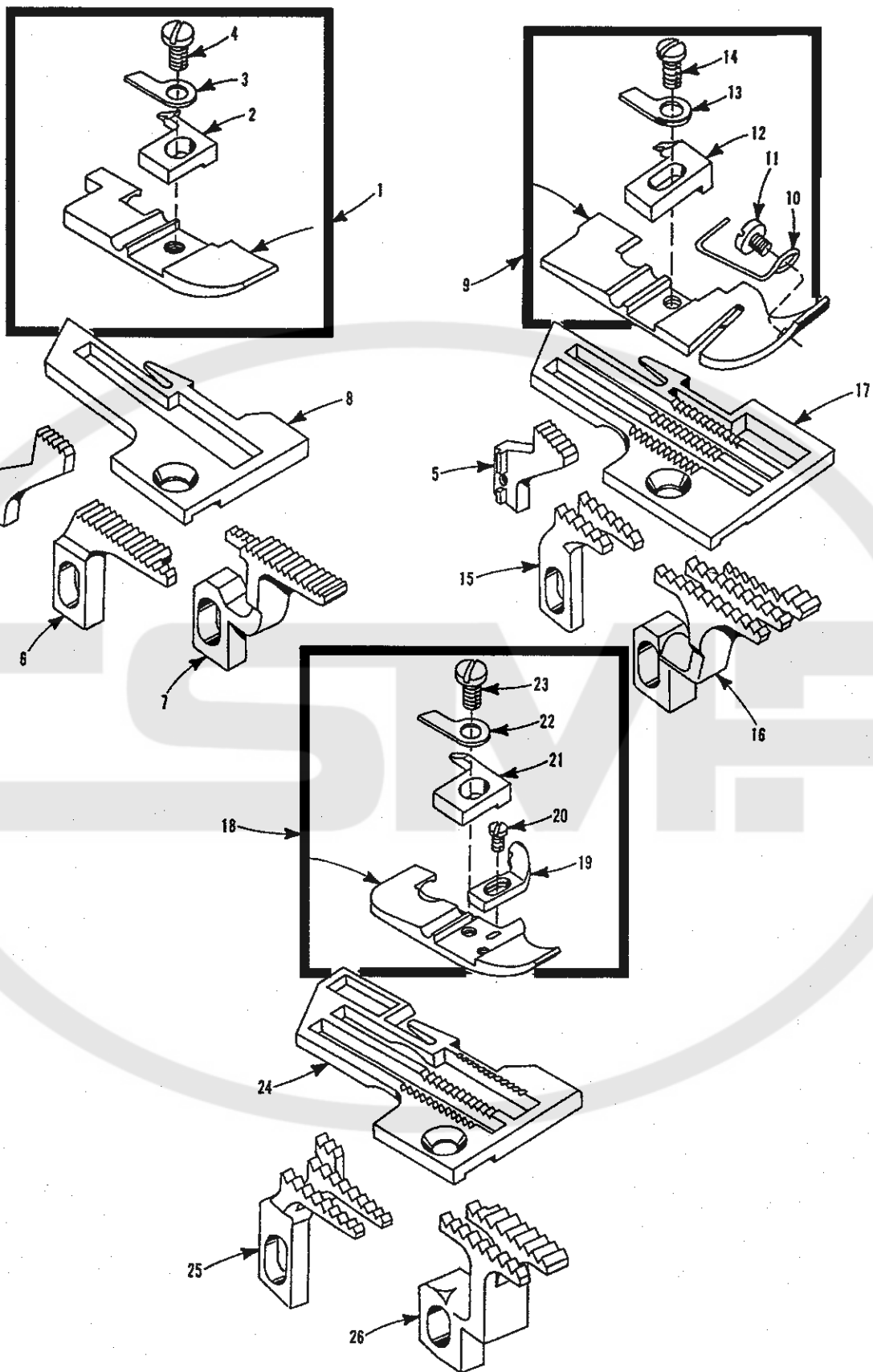
